

SUPPLEMENTAL PATTERN TO NOTEWORTHY

CREATE YOUR EVERGREEN TREE

The Noteworthy Quilt can be created in oodles of ways. Here is a basic map to get you started on creating your own tree for your quilt. The size of your tree will depend on the size of your quilt, which will also determine the size of flying geese you should make. Flying geese on the cover of Noteworthy Quilt pattern finish at 6" x 12" making the tree 63" tall.

Tree Branches:

From background fabric

cut (16) 6 3/4" x 6 3/4" squares

From tree fabric

cut (8) 6 3/4" x 12 3/4" rectangles

After trimming, geese will measure 6 1/2" x 12 1/2"

Tree Trunk:

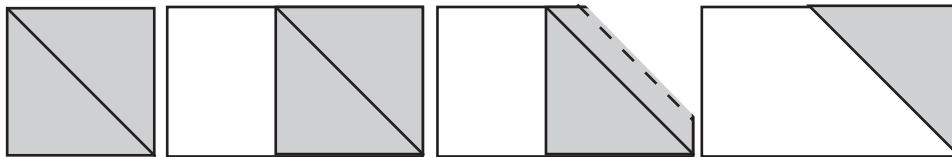
From background fabric

cut (2) 5" x 15.5" rectangles

From trunk fabric

cut (1) 3 1/2" x 15.5" rectangle

To sew flying geese:

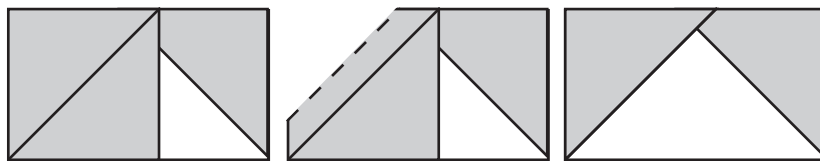


Mark all squares with diagonal line on wrong side.

Sew square to rectangle, right sides together, along marked line.

Cut fabric 1/4" above sewn line.

Iron. Press seam up to best use Bloc_Loc Ruler later



Sew square to rectangle on left side, right sides together, along marked line.

Cut fabric 1/4" above sewn line.

Iron. Press seam up. Square units using Bloc_Loc ruler.

When finished assembling tree, you're ready to add tree segment to your quilt. Go crazy and create an entire forest! It is your quilt, afterall.
